Post-Operative Care for Canine Castration

The next two weeks are very important to the health and well-being of your pet. The following is a list of instructions for you and your pet:

Do not allow running, jumping, climbing stairs, or uncontrolled activity.

Please restrict activity to leash walking for at least one week.

The suture line should be kept clean and dry. Bathing is not recommended until sutures are removed. Do not allow your pet to lick the incision or chew at the surgical area.

Check the incision line daily for increasing pain, swelling, discoloration, or discharge. If you notice any of these abnormalities please contact us.

Please return in two weeks if sutures are present. An appointment is not necessary.

Failure to follow these instructions can result in the irritation, infection, breakdown, and eventually opening of the incision line.
